Semester dates September 15th - January 31st


Spring semester February 10th – June 25th

LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

For English-Medium programs

TOEFL/IELTS/Cambridge certificates are not compulsory. Students are allowed to provide language certificate verified by their home University. The recommended level of language proficiency, should be at least B1.

Basic command of Russian language is recommended for comfortable stay in Russia

For Russian-Medium programs

The language proficiency certificate is not applicable, however student must have sufficient skills in writing/speaking/listening to attend lectures.

DOCUMENT SUBMISSION

The name of a student and the type of the document must be mentioned at the file title.

Before the arrival, provide the exchange coordinator with all the required information, so they could arrange transfer from the airport

VISA INVITATION

The visa invitation shall be issued to student after their application is processed by the International department.



COURSE SELECTION

The total number of credits obtained per semester – 30 ECTS.

Students select courses from the study plan offered. It is highly advisable to select all courses from one study plan. In the case courses are selected from study plans of different programs it should be noted that the courses may overlap in the schedule.

Course projects, master theses or other activity requiring scientific supervision is available in accordance with the workloads of the professors.

RUSSIAN LANGUAGE COURSE

If a student wants to attend a course of Russian language, he should preliminary inform the international coordinator at MAI about this, so they could check the availability of the groups at the required period.

ACCOMODATION

MAI provides accommodation for exchange students.

The cost is 90 USD per month. There are double and triple rooms available.

Exchange students live with other international students.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Is compulsory for all incoming students.

The cost of health insurance is around 135 USD. Students may obtain it upon their arrival.
