Length of the internshi p and your timetable

We accept interns and volunteers for periods no shorter than 3 months and no longer than 10 months. Internships can take from 24 to 30 hours per week, depending on your expectations and your university's demand.

In special cases, a twoweek internship is possible to be organized, with fulltime commitment of the intern for 40 hours per week.

Age groups

You can do your internship in:

- younger kindergarten group (2.5-3.5 y.o),
- middle kindergarten group (4 y.o),
- grade 0 (5-6 y.o),
- grade 1 (6-7 y.o),
- grade 2 (7-8 y.o)
- or in high school.

What do we aim for?

YOUR TASKS

during the internship

Necessary documentation

Every working day, you will sign a presence list. Please sign the presence list every day you are present at the school. Please be informed that you mustn't sign on the list in case you were absent. All absences have to be reported in advance to school coordinator. If an absence results from any other matter than an illness, you are going to need the coordinator's consent to take the day off, and you may be asked to make up for the absence on another day. If your absence is due to an illness, please deliver a doctor's certificate after you come back. When you arrive, you will also fill in a school check-in card, and we will ask you to present your passport or ID upon arrival.

An internship certificate will be issued after your internship finishes, and it will confirm the number of hours of your internship and provide a short assessment of your internship within particular criteria.

Mobile devices, electronics and photos

Please be informed that it is forbidden to use your mobile phone in the classroom for purposes other than the lesson. Please do not take photos of the students and do not publish their photos on any social media, blogs, websites, etc. Please do not use your laptop during your internship time, unless you are asked to do so by the teacher or you need the device to conduct your class.



Medical care

Depending on the type of insurance you have, you can use different health care options. Remember to have your ID or passport with you when you visit the doctor. If you come from a European country, make sure you have your EHIC (European Health Insurance Card).

Acommodation

During your internship, you will have to look for a room, flat, or a dormitory, as Cracow International School does not provide accommodation to its interns. There are many places where you can look for accommodation.

Student dormitories – they are usually the cheapest option, as all bills and internet connection are included in the price you pay per month. They are also located in places that are easily accessible by public transport, usually relatively close to the city center

and main universities. However, they are usually of low quality, often with a shared bathroom for a few rooms or even for a whole floor. You need to check available options directly at their websites. Please make sure to check the availability of places in advance, especially for stays during the academic vear when dorms are often full. Shared flats, shared rooms or single rooms —
they are usually a bit more expensive than
dormitories, but they tend to be of higher
quality. You usually have to pay a deposit,
except for the rent and the bills. Make sure
short-term rental option is available in case you
are not planning to stay for the whole academic
year. Sign a contract with a landlord or a rental
agency in order to be sure the flat or room is
being rented to you by its legal owner or his
representative. Check transport links, as cheaper
flats may be located in the suburbs. You can look

Transport links

The school does not have its own bus.

Therefore, you will

need to use public transport or other
means of transport. The closest bus stop
to the school is Pilotów. It is located in
zone 1. There are many buses that arrive to
this bus stop. If you are coming from more
remote areas of Cracow, you may need to
use a tram first and then take a bus. You
can use www.jakdojade.pl or a mobile app
'Jak Dojade' in order to check your
transport links.

If you are staying for at least a month, you can save money on transportation by buying a one-month, or a semester ticket.

One-time tickets can be bought in ticket machines located at bus stops and in buses/trams. If there is no ticket machine inside the vehicle, you can buy tickets directly from the driver, but you need to have the exact amount of money. Longterm tickets have to be bought at special offices. You can check ticket prices and ticket offices locations at www.mpk.krakow.pl.

If you decide to use taxis, avoid airport taxi services and those taxis that do not have their phone number written on the car door.

It is usually cheaper
to use a cab that you call for than
to use one that is already there
waiting for clients. You can easily
google taxi companies in Cracow
and check their prices online.
